Grant Application

Purpose of Fund

The intent of this \$250,000 Fund is to inspire our temple community to become personally engaged with their vision, passion, volunteer involvement and philanthropic resources to create new initiatives, and/or to strengthen existing programs and services.

Matching Grants

The Mina and Irving Klein Fund will match each initiative on a dollar-for-dollar basis, up to \$10,000. Matching grants will be funded for a period not to exceed three years.

The temple portion of the grant may be funded by:

- Temple partner(s)
- New major gift donations or available unrestricted major gift or endowment funds
- Revenue from annual operating funds, when appropriate
- Revenue from other restricted tribute funds, when appropriate

Funding Categories

The Mina and Irving Klein Fund will support funding categories including:

- Engagement and Partnership (Membership)
- Philanthropy and Stewardship
- Social Action and Social Justice
- Other Initiatives

Seed Funding

The Mina and Irving Klein Fund may be used to provide seed monies for certain initiatives. For instance, should the temple choose to sponsor meaningful education programs, funds could be made available to front the costs of such a program, with the understanding that a portion of the ticket proceeds may be redeposited to the Fund.

Factors the Ad Hoc Committee will Consider in Decision Making Process

- Does the initiative promote new ideas and innovative thinking
- Does the initiative generate partner engagement and strengthen existing programs and services
- What is the the timeline, and when appropriate, how will the initiative will become self-sustaining
- Letters of support from temple partners who are poised to serve as engaged volunteer leaders, or as funding sponsors of the initiative
